

Directions to the Accelerated Master's Program in Systems Engineering at the Darden Graduate School of Business, University of Virginia, Charlottesville

From the North - via I-66 and US Hwy 29 South:

Take I-66. Heading west from the DC area you will take Exit 43 A to U.S. Highway 29 South at the Gainesville/Warrenton exit. Follow U.S. 29 South to Charlottesville. As you approach the city you will pass shopping areas. After you pass Fashion Square Mall (on your left) move into the left lane for Business 29 before you reach the bypass. When U.S. 29 passes under the U.S. 250/Hwy 29 Bypass in Charlottesville, it becomes Emmet Street (Business 29). You will pass the Barracks Road Shopping Center on the right. Just beyond the shopping center, turn right at the traffic signal onto Arlington Boulevard. Continue on Arlington through one stoplight; then turn left at the stop sign when Arlington Boulevard ends at Massie Road. The entrance to the Darden School will be on your right just past the Law School. Turn right into the Darden School on Duffy Blvd.

From the Northeast – avoiding I-66:

(Alexandria, Annapolis, Baltimore, Fredericksburg)

(Once you get off I-95, this route is beautiful and usually has little traffic.)

Take Interstate 95 South to Fredericksburg, Virginia. Take exit 130 B onto Virginia Highway 3 West towards Culpeper. Continue on Hwy 3 West about 12 miles. You will pass the Chancellorsville Battlefield. Turn left at the stoplight at the Wilderness crossroads onto Highway 20 towards Orange (Constitution Highway). Continue on Highway 20 for approximately 22 miles. Turn left in Orange onto Highway 15 South towards Gordonsville (James Madison Highway). Continue on Hwy 15 for about 8 miles. At the traffic circle in Gordonsville, go around the circle 180 degrees and turn onto Virginia Hwy 231 South. After about 10 miles, Highway 231 becomes Hwy 22. (You may not notice the change.) Stay straight onto Hwy 22. Highway 22 ends at Highway 250. Bear right onto U.S. Highway 250 West. Turn left onto Interstate 64 West. Take Exit 118 onto U.S. Highway 29 North. Highway 29 N becomes the US 29 North / 250 East Bypass. Stay on the Route 29 Bypass and take the Leonard Sandridge Road exit (the third exit after getting onto 29) (Mapquest directions and maps show this as the North Grounds Connector Rd.). Turn left at the traffic light onto Massie Road. The entrance to the Darden School is on the left, just past the North Grounds Recreation Center. Turn left into the Darden School on Duffy Blvd. (See note below for return directions.)

From the East or West – via I – 64 and US Hwy 29 North:

Take Interstate 64 to Charlottesville. Take Exit 118 B onto U.S. Highway 29 North. Highway 29 N becomes the US 29 North / 250 East Bypass. Stay on the US 29/250 Bypass and take the Leonard Sandridge Road exit (the third exit after getting onto 29) (Mapquest directions and maps show this as the North Grounds Connector Rd.). Turn left at the traffic light onto Massie Road. The entrance to the Darden School is on the left,

just past the North Grounds Recreation Center. Turn left into the Darden School on Duffy Blvd. (See note below for return directions.)

From the South – via US Hwy 29 North:

Take U.S. Highway 29 North to Charlottesville. Highway 29 N becomes the US 29 North / 250 East Bypass. Stay on the US 29/250 Bypass and take the Leonard Sandridge Road exit (the third exit after passing under I-64) (Mapquest directions and maps show this as the North Grounds Connector Rd.). Turn left at the traffic light onto Massie Road. The entrance to the Darden School is on the left, just past the North Grounds Recreation Center. Turn left into the Darden School on Duffy Blvd. (See note below for return directions.)

Note -

Returning to Highway 29 South:

For those who used Leonard Sandridge Rd.

Leonard Sandridge Rd. does not have an entrance to go South on Hwy 29. Leaving the Darden School, turn right onto Massie Road. At the stoplight, turn left to stay on Massie Road. At the next stoplight (at U Hall and the John Paul Jones Arena) turn right onto Copeley Road. At the next stoplight, turn right onto US 250 West /Ivy Road. Follow US 250 W/Ivy Road to the overpass over Highway 29. Cross the bridge and turn left onto US 29 South.
